EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS NEEDED

UPCOMING TRAINING: Monday, December 9 | 7:30 pm

Precious Blood is now being offered on Sundays at the 8:30 am mass. In order to offer the Precious Blood at other masses an additional two ministers are needed at any mass where the Precious Blood is offered. At this time, there is no guarantee that enough ministers will be available to do this on a consistent basis at other weekend masses.

Everyone is asked to prayerfully consider becoming a Eucharistic Minister. Following a one-hour training session, you will be installed as a minister and asked to assist at mass 1-3 times a month, at your preferred mass. Without additional participation, it will not be feasible to offer the Precious Blood at other masses.

The next training opportunity will be on Monday, December 9, beginning at 7:30 pm in Church. This training is open both to Eucharistic Ministry candidates, and active Eucharistic Ministers who want a refresher course on distributing the Precious Blood.

St. Peter's is again providing the Christmas Giving Tree to help the less fortunate fulfill some holiday wishes.

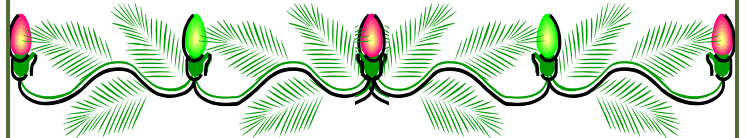
Here is how it works:
