### RECEIVING EUCHARIST AT HOME

If you or a family member are homebound, or unable for any reason to attend mass, you are still able to receive Holy Communion. We have a group of individuals who are Ministers of Care. These people are commissioned to bring Holy Communion to the homebound.

Each week, they will visit your home and bring the Eucharist and a smile to those who cannot attend mass. They will work with you to try to accommodate to your schedule, and can make adjustments on a week-to-week basis if needed.

To make arrangements to have someone bring Eucharist to your home, for one or two weeks, or on an ongoing basis, please contact the church office. They will need to know the name, address and phone number of the person(s) who will be receiving. Remember that if a caregiver is present in the home, they too can receive Eucharist during the visit.

During this time of the Eucharistic Revival, we want to encourage all parishioners to receive the blessed sacrament on a regular basis. Please consider taking advantage of this special ministry.



### EUCHARISTIC MINISTER TRAINING WEDNESDAY, JULY 3 | 7:00 PM

A training session will take place on Wednesday, July 3, beginning at 7:00 pm in Margaret Woods Hall, for anyone interested in becoming Eucharistic Ministers. Following the initial presentation, training will move to the church to allow ministers to practice. If you have been a Eucharistic Minister in the past, and would like to begin assisting again, please join us. If you were a Eucharistic Minister at a different parish, and would like to serve again, please join us.

As a Eucharistic Minister, you will be asked to assist at mass 1-2 times a month. You are scheduled based on your availability. Please note that bringing Communion to the homebound is a separate ministry. We will be offering training for these Ministers of Care later this year.

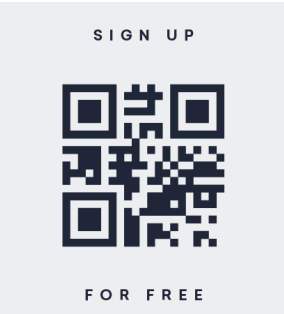
