### MASS OF THANKSGIVING

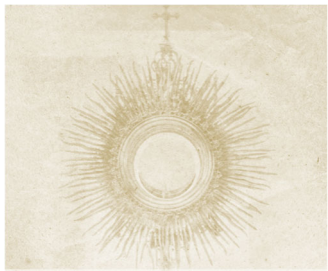
THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 28 | 9:00 AM

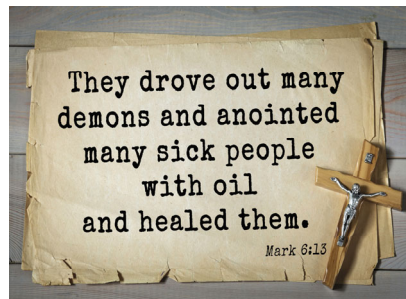
### FIRST FRIDAY EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

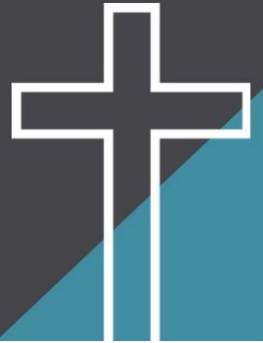

## EUCCHARISTIC Ministers

### THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF CHRIST

Beginning Sunday, December 1, we will begin offering the Precious Blood of Christ along with His Sacred Body at all 8:30 am masses. This is possible because of the number of Eucharistic Ministers (EMs) are available to assist at the 8:30 am mass. Unfortunately, we do not have enough EMs available at the other masses to be able to offer the Precious Blood at these masses.

When you receive Holy Communion, whether the Sacred Host or the Precious Blood, you are receiving the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ at that moment. You are welcome to receive both species, Body and Blood, when you come forward for Communion. Please note that intinction, or the dunking of the Host in the Precious Blood is NOT to be done. If you wish to receive the Precious Blood, after (or instead of) receiving the Body of Christ, go to the Minister of the Cup and give a slight bow of reverence. The Minister will offer the cup, saying "The Blood of Christ." You should reply "Amen," then gently take the cup, take a small sip, and return the cup to the Minister.

We are glad to be able to once again offer the Blood of Christ at mass, and hope that you will take the opportunity to receive Jesus in both species, Body and Blood, when you attend our 8:30 am masses.

Light up someone's holiday

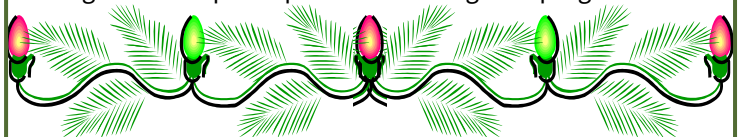
St. Peter's is again providing the Christmas Giving Tree to help the less fortunate fulfill some holidays wishes.

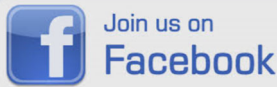
