## PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear parishioners:

***I would like to share with you the following story which I received, and thought is beautiful...***

One day, when I was a freshman in high school, I saw a kid from my class walking home from school. His name was Kyle. It looked like he was carrying all his books. I thought, "Why would anyone bring home all his books on a Friday? He must be a nerd."

I had quite a weekend planned (parties and a football game with friends the next afternoon), so I shrugged my shoulders and went on. As I was walking, I saw some kids running toward him, knocking all his books out of his arms and tripping him so he landed in the dirt. His glasses flew, and I saw them land in the grass about ten feet from him.

He looked up, and I saw this terrible sadness in his eyes. My heart went out to him. So, I jogged over to him as he crawled around looking for his glasses, and I saw a tear in his eye. I handed him his glasses and said, "Those guys are jerks." He looked at me and said thank you with a big smile. It was one of those smiles that showed genuine gratitude. I helped him pick up his books and asked where he lived. As it turned out, he lived near me, so I asked him why I had never seen him. He said he had gone to a private school before. I had never hung out with a private school kid before, but we talked all the way home, and he turned out to be pretty cool. I invited him to play football with me and my friends. We hung out all weekend, and the more I got to know Kyle, the more I liked him, and my friends thought the same about him.

Monday morning came, and there was Kyle again with a massive stack of books. I stopped him and said, "Boy, you are gonna really build some serious muscles with this pile of books every day!" He just laughed and handed me half the books. Over the next four years, Kyle and I became best friends. When we were seniors, we began to think about college. Kyle decided on Georgetown, and I planned to go to Duke. I knew we would always be friends, and the miles would never be a problem. He would be a doctor, and I was going for business on a football scholarship. Kyle was the valedictorian of our class. I teased him all the time about being a nerd.

I was so glad I didn't have to get up there and speak on graduation day. I saw Kyle and he looked great. He was one of those guys that found himself in high school. He filled out and looked good in glasses. He had more dates than I had, and all the girls loved him. Boy, sometimes I was jealous! Today was one of those days. I could see that he was nervous about his speech. So, I smacked him on the back and said, "Hey, big guy, you'll be great!" He looked at me with one of those looks (the grateful one), smiled, and thanked me. As he started his speech, he cleared his throat and began. "Graduation is a time to thank those who helped you make it through those tough years. Your parents, teachers, siblings, maybe a coach... but mostly your friends... I am here to tell you a story about my friend." I just stared at Kyle in disbelief as he told the story of the first day we met. He had planned to kill himself over the weekend. He talked of how he had cleaned out his locker so his Mom wouldn't have to do it later and was carrying his stuff home. He looked hard at me and gave me a little smile. "Thankfully, I was saved. My friend saved me from doing the unspeakable."

I heard the gasp go through the crowd as this handsome, popular boy told us all about his weakest moment. I saw his Mom and Dad looking at me and smiling that same grateful smile. Not until that moment did I realize its depth. Never underestimate the power of your actions. With one small gesture, you can change a person's life—for better or for worse. God puts us all in each other's lives to impact one another in some way. Look for God in others. And always remember — "Friends are angels who lift us to our feet when our wings have trouble remembering how to fly."

## Order of Christian Initiation for Adults

- > *Have you thought about becoming Catholic?*

- > *What does it mean that "we receive Jesus in the Host" the priest raises up?*

The **Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA)**, formerly RCIA, is a program available to adults seeking to become a full member of the Roman Catholic Church. Full membership in the Catholic Church involves a formation process, which includes the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Most Holy Eucharist. While coming to know Jesus and His invitation to become a disciple, the OCIA process involves the journey of faith and conversion. A person is introduced to the beliefs, life, liturgy, and apostolic work of the Catholic Church.

To start the process of Initiation, one should:

- 1) Begin learning prayers and building a habit of daily prayer;
- 2) Be open to the fullness of Catholic teaching and life; and
- 3) Begin to live according to the fullness of Catholic life even now living the moral life.


