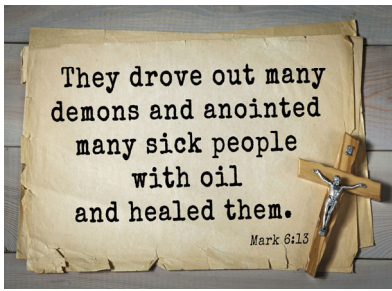

ANOINTING OF THE SICK AND HEALING MASS

Beginning in September, an Anointing of the Sick and Healing Mass will take place quarterly on the first Saturday of the quarter at 8:30am (note - this is a new time for all First Saturday Masses).

The sacrament of Anointing is not limited to those who are dying. According to the Catechism, "The anointing of the sick is not a sacrament for those only who are at the point of death. Hence, as soon as anyone of the faithful begins to be in danger of death from sickness or old age, the fitting time for him to receive this sacrament has certainly already arrived" (CCC 1514).

If you or a loved one feels the need for healing and anointing, please plan to attend this Mass to receive the special graces offered by the sacrament: the uniting of the sick person to the passion of Christ, for his own good and that of the whole Church; the strengthening, peace, and courage to endure in a Christian manner the sufferings of illness or old age; the forgiveness of sins, if the sick person was not able to obtain it through the sacrament of penance; the restoration of health, if it is conducive to the salvation of his soul; the preparation for passing over to eternal life" (CCC 1532).

Anointing of the Sick is an opportunity to bring our chronic ills of body, mind, and spirit to the Lord in a special way. The Sacrament is often an experience of God's healing love.

All are invited to bring their needs for physical, emotional and spiritual healing to this beautiful liturgy, especially those who are experiencing the various infirmities that afflict bodies in later years, or those who are anticipating surgery soon.



EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS NEEDED

UPCOMING TRAINING: Monday, September 9 | 7:00 pm

We have been discussing the possibility of returning to offering the Precious Blood at weekend masses. The main obstacle to being able to do this is a lack of Eucharistic ministers. We will need an additional two ministers at any mass where we offer the Precious Blood, and at this time we cannot guarantee that we will have enough ministers to do this on a consistent basis at any of our four weekend masses.

We ask all of you to prayerfully consider becoming a Eucharistic Minister. Following a one-hour training session, you will be installed as a minister, and asked to assist at mass 2-3 times a month, at your preferred mass. Without your participation, we will not be able to offer the Precious Blood of Christ during mass.

Our next training opportunity will be on Monday, September 9th beginning at 7:00 pm in Woods Hall. This training is open both to Eucharistic Ministry candidates, and active Eucharistic ministers who want a refresher course on distributing the Precious Blood.

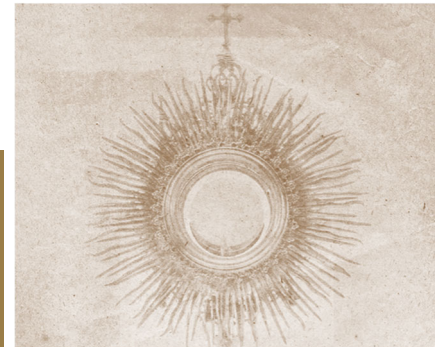

PRAYER SERVICE

A nine-month pilgrimage of the Silver Rose will be the centerpiece of a special prayer service at St. Peter the Apostle Parish in Itasca, on Tuesday August 30 at 7:30 pm.

The Knights of Columbus and St. Peter the Apostle – Itasca – Council 10884 will honor Our Lady of Guadalupe and express both international unity and dedication to the sanctity of human life.

The journey of the Silver Rose began on February 25 this year and ends on December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. During that time, Silver Roses travel from town to town along eight routes throughout North America. Several of those routes begin in Canada and end in Mexico. The Silver Rose Program began in 1960, when the first rose – a live one – was blessed by a bishop in Ontario. The rose then traveled to New York and then to Texas where it was taken across the border into Mexico. The rose ended its pilgrimage at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey on December 12, the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

To better ensure future annual trips, a "silver rose" was ultimately created. Today, due to the popularity of the program throughout the North American continent, eight silver roses travel unique routes.

All members of the community are invited to join the Knights of Columbus and St. Peter the Apostle – Itasca – Council 10884 to pray for a civilization of love and culture of life in our own country and throughout the world. *Please spread the word!*

Founded in 1882 to assist working-class and immigrant Catholics in the United States, today approximately two million members of the Knights of Columbus put their faith into action through a broad range of charitable causes locally, nationally and internationally through financial contributions and hands-on service.
